Our summer camps offer a variety of activities and learning experiences for kids of all ages. Located on a sprawling farm in Buxton, Maine, your child's camp experience will be one they will treasure for years to come.



### Half Pint Camp

AGES 4 – 8

#### Fun on the Farm

Half days from 9am - 1pm, M-F

July 23 – 27

August 6 – 10

Cost per week: \$300

In our Half Pint half-day camp, children will learn the basics of respecting and caring for horses and other animals. They will learn to become comfortable around horses as they learn the importance of safety and proper barn etiquette.

- Learning to groom, tack and ride a horse

- Basic farm chores

### Horsemanship Camp

AGES 8 – 12

Full days from 9am - 4pm, M-F

Session 1 June 25 – June 29

Session 2 July 16 – July 20

Session 3 July 30 – August 3

Cost per week: \$350

Our Horsemanship Camp is a great introduction to the basics of horse care and riding. Learning takes place on and off the horse in the form of games and group activities.

#### Horsemanship Camp activities consist of:

- Learning the points of a horse, tack elements and care, vaulting, horse painting, trail rides, horse health including biology and first aid, horse bathing & games
- Blacksmithing demonstrations
- Equine dental demonstrations



### Rodeo Camp

AGES 10 – 16

#### The Real Cowboy Experience

Full days from 9am - 4pm, M-F

July 23 – 27

Cost per week: \$350

Campers will learn western style riding, parts of western tack, barrels, poles, roping & reining.

### Teen Girls Camp

AGES 13 - 18

Full days from 9am - 4pm, M-F

August 6 – 10

Cost: \$350

Experiential learning with our equine partners helps participants see themselves differently as they explore the differences and similarities between the social and emotional aspects of horses and themselves.

From beginning to end, participants will be aware that the horse mirrors and reacts to the emotions present when they interact with people.

#### Camp activities include:

- Journaling
- Native American belief studies
- Henna body painting, horse painting
- Bareback riding
- Vaulting & mounted team challenges
